YOUTH SUPPORT WORKER

The job description of the Youth Support Worker consists of several duties and responsibilities that relate to providing guidance and support to youth & families in need. Ability to work with high-risk youth – empower, support youth with goals and outcomes. Youth Support Worker will need to follow job description.
