  - International single axle Gravel/Water truck (summer) Plow/Sanders truck (snow removal)
  - Takeuchi TL 150 (bobcat) with various attachments
  - Terex 760 Back Hoe
  - Sterling Gravel truck with tri-axle equipment trailer (haul heavy equipment)
