- Job Type: Full-time (30 hours/week), fixed term contract, contract length: 9 weeks

Full Job Description

- FRFA is an inclusive organization. Job tasks will include cleaning (i.e. some combination of cages, litter boxes, water and food bowls, bedding, floors), and feeding cats. Grooming and administering medications may also be required. Applicants must be self-starters, observant, patient, kind, and in reasonable physical condition. Actual duties and hours will be determined based upon the best fit between the shelter and the individual. The shelter is on a bus route in the McCall area (just east of Deerfoot Trail, between McKnight Blvd. and 32 Ave NE). Parking is available.

This is a Canada Summer Jobs sponsored position. Applicants do not have to be students, but must be:

- Between 15 and 30 years of age at the beginning of the 9 week employment period, which will fall between April 25, 2022 and Sept 3, 2022.
- A Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act for the duration of the employment
- Have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations. International students are not eligible participants.

FRFA welcomes applications from all individuals, including those who are Indigenous, racialized, or any other dimension of diversity.
