### **Position Summary:**

Precious Cargo's Family Visitation Program provides child/youth transportation services, supported visitation, and monitored exchanges to families in need of intervention. Children are provided with a safe environment to visit and form healthy relationships with their caregivers. Under the agency's policies and professional requirements, the Family Support Worker will provide hands-on direct assistance and parent-coaching to families and children who are referred for Supervised Visitation services. This may include child transportation, in person support, remote support, fully supported or semi-supported visits at approved visitation sites, and parent coaching before, during, and after visits.

## **Major Responsibilities:**

Clearly define expectations of visitation services with all parties. Establish and maintain appropriate professional relationships with participants, and provide all necessary documentation regarding the visitation services (reports, case updates, etc.)
