



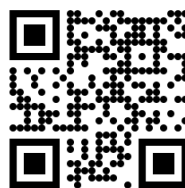

You convey information regarding regulations, recommend activities and excursions, interpret safety messages, consult on backcountry planning, resolve visitor dilemmas/complaints; process payments, support the sanitation team with cleaning and maintenance of public washrooms as well as office space and grounds. Usually work indoors. Include entry pass and merchandise sales.</p> <p><b>Lake Louise Shuttle &amp; Traffic Management</b> Attendants interact with visitors to process shuttle reservations, provide visitor information on the shuttle system and answer visitor questions, provide park pass, and shuttle ticket sales to visitors, clean and maintain public washrooms as well as office space and grounds.</p>
